



Admission Process & Application Checklist

STEP 1: Tour



Visit www.shorecrest.org/tour (or scan the code) to schedule a private campus tour

STEP 2: Apply

- Visit: www.shorecrest.org/apply
- Pay one-time \$85 application fee* (*International applicants \$200 fee)
- Submit application

STEP 3: Submit Required Documentation

Experiential School (Alpha & JK)

- Photo
- Birth Certificate
- Shadow Visit

Please note: International applicants are required to submit a passport and/or visa as part of their application materials.

Lower School (Grades K-4)

- Photo
- Birth Certificate
- School Records (1 previous year + 1st semester of current year if applicable)
- Teacher Recommendation
- Standardized assessment* (*Kindergarten only)
- Shadow Visit

Middle & Upper Schools (Grades 5-12)

- Photo
- Birth Certificate
- School Records (1 previous year + 1st semester of current year)
- Teacher Recommendation(s) (5th grade requires only one (1) teacher recommendation)
- Standardized Test Scores: ISEE, SSAT, PSAT, SAT or ACT (TOFEL required for international applicants)
- Shadow Visit
- Complete Character Snapshot*
- Admission Interview (where the Shadow Visit is strongly encouraged, the Admission Interview is required)
- Placement assessments

* Applicants for grades 6-12 are required to submit a Character Snapshot (<https://www.admission.org/services/character-skills-snapshot>). Assessments taken by January 24 will be considered in the first round of admissions decisions. Assessments received after January 24 will be considered in the second round of admissions.

Additional Details

A photo and birth certificate (passport for international applicants) must be attached to submit an application. School Records/Report Cards may be uploaded to the application via the Application Portal.

Teacher Recommendations may be requested through the Application Portal. You will need the teacher's email address, and our system will do the rest!

Standardized Test Scores*:

ISEE: Register online at iseeonline.erblearn.org

SSAT: Register online at ssat.org (School Code - 7358)

In lieu of ISSE & SSAT, we also accept PSAT, SAT, or ACT scores.

International Applicants: TOFEL scores required 5th through 12th.

** Shorecrest will accept scores from any standardized test the applicant has taken during their current school year. If your student has not taken a standardized test within the current school year, applicants must take either the ISEE or SSAT.*

Financial Aid Applications

Shorecrest has a fixed financial aid budget that allows us to offer need-based tuition assistance to families that qualify.

Priority is given to students of faculty and staff, current families, and families with students new to the Middle and Upper Schools (grades 5-12).

Families interested in receiving aid must complete a Financial Aid Application through FACTS, an external resource used to determine estimated family contribution.

Key Dates

September 1, 2023:

- 2024-2025 School year application opens

January 24, 2024:

- Last Day to take the Character Snapshot (applicants grades 6 -12 for the first round of admissions decisions)

February 1, 2024:

- Completed applications (includes the completion of all checklist items) are due to be considered for the first round of admissions decisions.
- Last day to have a student visit for the first round of admissions decisions.
- Completed FACTS applications are due for families who wish to be considered for financial aid assistance.

Late February 2024:

- The first round of admissions decisions are shared

March 2024:

- Second round of admissions decisions begin
