#### February 1, 2024:

- Completed applications (includes the completion of all checklist items) are due to be considered for the first round of admissions decisions.
- Last day to have a student visit for the first round of admissions decisions.
- Completed FACTS applications are due for families who wish to be considered for financial aid assistance.

#### Late February 2024:

• The first round of admissions decisions are shared

#### March 2024:

• Second round of admissions decisions begin
