

Admission Process & Application Checklist

PART 1: Submit an application

- ☐ Scan the QR code to start the online application
(or visit: www.shorecrest.org/apply)
- ☐ Pay one-time \$85 application fee*
*International applicants \$200 fee
- ☐ Upload student photo to application portal
- ☐ Upload birth certificate to application portal
- ☐ Submit application



PART 2: Follow-up steps after submitting the application

Experiential School (Alpha & JK)

- ☐ Schedule Shadow Visit

Please note: International applicants are required to submit a passport and/or visa as part of their application materials.

Lower School (Grades K-4)

- ☐ Schedule Shadow Visit
- ☐ Submit School Records
One previous year and first semester of current year, if applicable
- ☐ Submit Teacher Recommendation
Grades 1-4 only
- ☐ Standardized assessment
Kindergarten only

Middle & Upper Schools (Grades 5-12)

- ☐ Schedule Shadow Visit
Applicants participate in an Admission Interview and Placement Assessment on the day of their visit
- ☐ Submit School Records
One previous year and first semester of current year, if applicable
- ☐ Submit Teacher Recommendation(s)
5th grade requires only one teacher recommendation
- ☐ Standardized Test Scores
TOFEL required for international applicants

Additional Details

A photo and birth certificate (passport for international applicants) must be attached to submit an application. School Records/Report Cards may be uploaded to the application via the Application Portal.

Teacher Recommendations may be requested through the Application Portal. You will need the teacher's email address, and our system will do the rest!

Standardized Test Scores*:

ISEE: Register online at iseeonline.erblearn.org

SSAT: Register online at ssat.org (School Code—7358)

International Applicants: TOFEL scores required 5th through 12th.

* Shorecrest will accept scores from any standardized test the applicant has taken within the past year. If your student has not taken a standardized test within the past year, applicants must take either the ISEE or SSAT.

Financial Aid Applications

Shorecrest has a fixed financial aid budget that allows us to offer need-based tuition assistance to families that qualify.

Priority is given to students of faculty and staff, current families, and families with students new to the Middle and Upper Schools (grades 5-12).

Families interested in receiving aid must complete a Financial Aid Application through FACTS, an external resource used to determine estimated family contribution.

Key Dates

September 1, 2025:

- 2026-2027 school year application opens

February 1, 2026:

- Completed applications (includes the completion of all checklist items) are due to be considered for the first round of admissions decisions.
- Last day to have a student visit for the first round of admissions decisions.
- Completed FACTS applications are due for families who wish to be considered for financial aid assistance.

Late February 2026:

- The first round of admissions decisions are shared

March 2026:

- Second round of admissions decisions begin
