Job Summary:

The Varsity Baseball Coach, under the Athletic Director's supervision, is responsible for developing the baseball program at Shorecrest that includes both Middle School and Varsity teams. In this role the primary responsibility will be coaching the Varsity team while providing direction to the Middle School team during our Spring sports season.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Teaches appropriate fundamentals, techniques and skills
- Responsible for the health and safety of the athletes
- Articulates a well-defined and understandable coaching philosophy
- Applies developmental and age-appropriate methods to coaching student-athletes
- Emphasizes sportsmanship and leadership among athletes
- Clearly communicates with players, parents, administrators and staff, including submitting a post-game recap form for official school records and communication
- Positively motivates athletes and promotes teamwork
- Attends all meetings and training as required by the Athletic Director
- Completes all Shorecrest Human Resources and FHSAA compliance requirements in a timely manner
- Is familiar with and complies with all policies as put forth in Shorecrest documents
- Distributes, collects and is responsible for team uniforms
- Manages and maintains team equipment
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Athletic Director

- Deep knowledge of the intricacies of the game of baseball
