

## Upper School: Grades 9-12

### OVERVIEW

#### Deposit

All payment plans require a non-refundable \$1,500 tuition deposit per student due upon enrollment to reserve a space in the class. The deposit is applied toward tuition.

#### Payment Plan Terms

*Semi-Annual and Monthly Payment Plan options are available for an additional fee.*

##### Annual Plan Tuition:

One payment due May 2024.

##### Semi-Annual Plan Tuition:

Two payments; 60% of tuition due May 2024, remaining balance due October 2024.

##### Monthly Plan Tuition:

Ten payments due May 2024 - February 2025.

#### Billing & Payment through FACTS

Families are required to set up and maintain a FACTS Tuition Management account for payment of tuition and fees.

Shorecrest accepts payments made by EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) from a checking or savings account or by credit card (subject to a 2.95% convenience fee) directly to FACTS Tuition Management. Shorecrest also accepts payments made via personal check, cashier's check, bank check or money order.

Tuition includes lunch and Shorecrest Community Association membership. Tuition payments do not cover the cost of books, supplies, transportation, special event admission fees, or other expenses incurred in the ordinary course of a student's activities at Shorecrest. All other charges will be itemized when billed. All charges, including tuition, must be kept current. A late fee will be assessed if payments are not made as scheduled in FACTS.

#### Tuition Refund Insurance

Families are automatically enrolled in the Tuition Refund Insurance plan unless they choose to opt-out during the re-enrollment process, if eligible.

Families may not opt out of the Tuition Refund Insurance (2.4% of tuition cost) if the Semi-Annual Plan or Monthly Tuition Plan is selected AND one of the following is true:

- a new family enrolling a student in Shorecrest for the first time
- a new student enrolling after the school year has begun
- a student returning to the school after an absence of one semester or more

Enrollment contracts obligate families to pay the full year's tuition unless the school is notified in writing prior to July 1, 2024 that your student will not be attending Shorecrest during the 2024-2025 school year. Insurance is especially beneficial for those who may be relocating or may need to withdraw a student for any reason during the school year.

*The Tech Fee covers a school-issued laptop for grades 9-11. 12th graders in the Class of 2025 are required to have an approved iPad or Mac laptop provided by the family. The estimated range for that purchase is \$500-1,500*
